

CONSTITUTION OF PRAIRIE PLAYERS

1. NAME

The name of the Society shall be PRAIRIE PLAYERS.

2. OBJECTIVES

- a) To encourage members to enjoy and develop their interest and talent in amateur theatre through participation in the preparation and presentation of productions to the public; to use these skills to aid others in selected areas of dramatic production.
- b) Shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to PRAIRIE PLAYERS shall be used in promoting its objectives.

3. MEMBERSHIP

In matters of admission to and expulsion from membership, PRAIRIE PLAYERS shall adhere to the terms of the By-Laws.

4. OFFICERS

- a) The affairs of PRAIRIE PLAYERS shall be managed by the Executive which shall consist of not more than six and not less than five members, and shall include the following officers: President, Vice-President, Past President Secretary, Treasurer and a minimum of one member-at-large.
- b) Shall function according to the terms of the By-Laws.

5. AMENDMENTS TO THE GOVERNING DOCUMENTS

- a) Amendments to the Constitution shall **only** be made at the Annual General Meeting and passed by a two-thirds majority vote of members present. A 30 day notice must be given to membership.
- b) The Executive shall be empowered to make amendments to the By-Laws upon submission at the next General Meeting and passed by a two-thirds majority vote of members present.

6. DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution of PRAIRIE PLAYERS, material assets may be liquidized and the proceeds along with funds, useful equipment and properties are to be turned over to the William Glesby Centre, Portage la Prairie, Manitoba.

No such dissolution shall be passed until carried by seventy-five percent of members present.
